85 Non-Profits Pick Up Furniture in Frenzied Giveaway

Office Liquidators Donates \$56,464 Worth of Inventory

LAKEWOOD – A crowd of people that began lining up at 4:10 a.m. took away \$56,464 worth of used and refurbished office furniture from Office Liquidators today, all in the name of charity.
